Isaiah 50:4-11

AS A DISCIPLE

- In Israel there are none who are left to hear the call of the Lord (v. 1-3).
- Here is the one who will hear and through Him we may hear (v. 4-5).
- There is tremendous value in approaching someone as a fellow hearer (Heb. 5:8).
- Consider the constancy of giving your ear to God (Deut. 6:6-9).

A FACE LIKE FLINT

- Obedience to God cost Jesus more than it will ever cost anyone else (Heb. 12:4).
- But we have not even born the costs of many other servants of God (Heb. 11).
- It is possible for us to have this determination as well (Ezek 3:9; 1 Pet. 4:4).
- The reason we can stand firm with such determination is because we trust in God (Rom. 8:31).

TWO OPTIONS

- You can come to His light (v. 10).
- You can burn the house down around yourself by trying to make your own light (v. 11).
