THE STORY OF HABAKKUK

- “How long, oh Lord” (1:2)?
- “I am raising up the Chaldeans” (1:5).
- “You O Rock, have established them to correct” (1:12).
- “Why do you look with favor on those who deal treacherously” (1:13)?
- “I will keep watch to see what He will speak to me” (2:1).
- “Wait for it” (2:3).
- “Be silent before Him” (2:20).
- “In wrath, remember mercy” (3:2).
- “You went forth for the salvation of Your people” (3:13).
- “Yet I will exult in the Lord” (3:19).

THE MESSAGE OF HABAKKUK

- God will bring justice to the proud (Rom. 12:19).
- The righteous will live by being faithful to God (2:4; 3:16-19).
- A relationship with God has always been based on faith in the face of deserved judgment (Rom. 1:17; Gal. 3:11; Heb. 10:38).
