SPECIFIC AND GENERIC

- There are times where it is appropriate to simply point out someone's hypocrisy (Lk. 20:2-8).
- Very often these charges are lobbed when we act without "specific" authority (Matt. 12:1-8).
- People use generic commands to avoid action (Lk. 10:29).
- "Generic" and "specific" are relative terms.
- The more specific, the less liberty (Eph. 5:19).
- We are given many generic commands without any specific instructions.
