- 15 So the wall was finished on the twenty-fifth day of Elul, in fifty-two days.
- 16 And it happened, when all our enemies heard of it, and all the nations around us saw these things, that they were very disheartened in their own eyes; for they perceived that this work was done by our God.



Fifty-Two Days

- The Condition of the People of Jerusalem
 - In great distress and reproach (Neh. 1:3a)
- The Condition of the Walls of Jerusalem
 - Broken down and the gates burned with fire (Nehemiah 1:3b; 2:13)
- Their Enemies Plotted Against Them
 - Nehemiah 4:1-3, 7-8

Fifty-Two Days

- The Remnant had Strong, Godly Leadership
 - Nehemiah (2:17-20); Ezra (Ezra 7:10; Neh. 8:1-8)
- The People had a Mind to Work
 - Nehemiah 4:6

Fifty-Two Days

- The People Joined Together in a United Effort
 - Nehemiah 3

- Continued to Work & were Prepared to Fight
 - Nehemiah 4:16-23

- Read Through the Entire New Testament!
 - I Timothy 4:13; Psalm 1:2; Matthew 4:4; 5:6
- End Bad Habit, Begin Good Habit! (Eph. 4:20-24)
 - Smoking, Temper, Corrupt Speech, TV, Video Games,
 Facebook, Internet Surfing, Etc.
 - Pray, Visit Sick, Family Bible Study, Hospitable, etc.
- Make at Least One Spiritual Contact!
 - Matthew 9:36-38
