- Come to know God as Creator through His word (Psalm 1:1-6; 19:7-14; 139:1-24).

How Do You Remember God in Your Youth

- Pursue a relationship with your Creator through His Christ (John 1:1-3, 14; 14:6; Gal. 2:20; Phil. 3:9-10).
- Build relationships with those who are friends of the Creator (Acts 2:42-46; 4:32; I Cor. 15:33).

Potential of Those Who Remember God in Youth

- Steadfast servants: Joseph (Gen. 39:5-9).
- Live with divine purpose: Daniel (1:8).
- Pursue a sense of mission (Luke 2:40-52).

The Wisdom of Serving God In Youth

- Develop godly discipline (1 Cor. 9:27; 1 Tim. 4:6-8).
- Commit yourself to discipleship (Matt. 6:33; 16:24).
- Hear the voice of wisdom early on in your life (Pro. 1:7-23).
- Equip yourself for the winter of life (Eccl. 12:1-7, 13, 14).
- Prepare for Judgment (Eccl. 12:13, 14).
