



APPLICATION. The Maccabees (Hasmoneans) had fought against the Greeks to protect themselves from religious compromise, but they were in many ways blind to the ways that Hellenistic culture was affecting them and ended up compromising in some pretty big ways. We must be watchful. We are no better than they if we avoid doctrinal or moral compromise in certain areas but permit it in others. "Stand up, stand up for Jesus!" ...
