**Nations Present at Pentecost**

**Acts 2:9-11** “Parthians and Medes and Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, <sup>10</sup> Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya around Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, <sup>11</sup> Cretans and Arabs—we hear them in our own tongues speaking of the mighty deeds of God.”

# Acts 2:14-21

- Peter's sermon:
  - Introduction
  - Joel 2
- 21 'And it shall be that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'

# Acts 2:22-36

- 1st Premise – God raised Jesus, v. 22-32
  - Proof 1: Psalm 16
  - Proof 2: Witnesses
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Premise – He is ascended, exalted to the throne, 32-35
  - Proof 1: Sending of the Holy Spirit (Jesus said He would send the Spirit)
  - Proof 2: Psalm 110
- Conclusion: Jesus is both Lord and Christ, v. 36
  - Lord – King
  - Christ – anointed One, Messiah

# Acts 2:37-40

- “Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”
- “Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ **so that your sins may be forgiven...**”, NIV
  - The gift is from the Holy Spirit
  - The gift is the Holy Spirit

# Acts 2:41-47

- “Those who had received his word were baptized...”
  - 3000 souls were added
  - v. 47 - The Lord was adding to their number daily those who “were being saved.”
- Devoted themselves to spiritual things: the apostles’ teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread (Lord’s Supper), and to prayer.
- They took care of each other and shared what they had.
  - Continued with one mind in the temple
  - Breaking bread from house to house
  - Taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart,
- They had favor with all the people.
